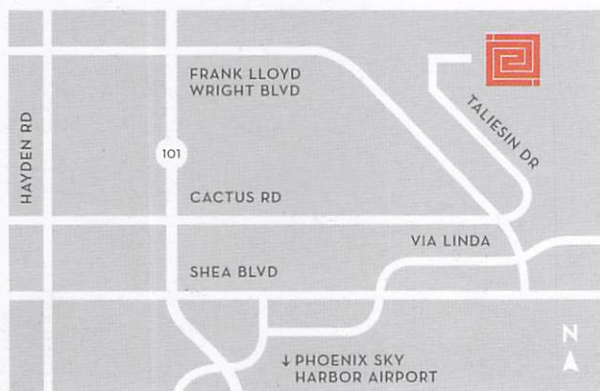

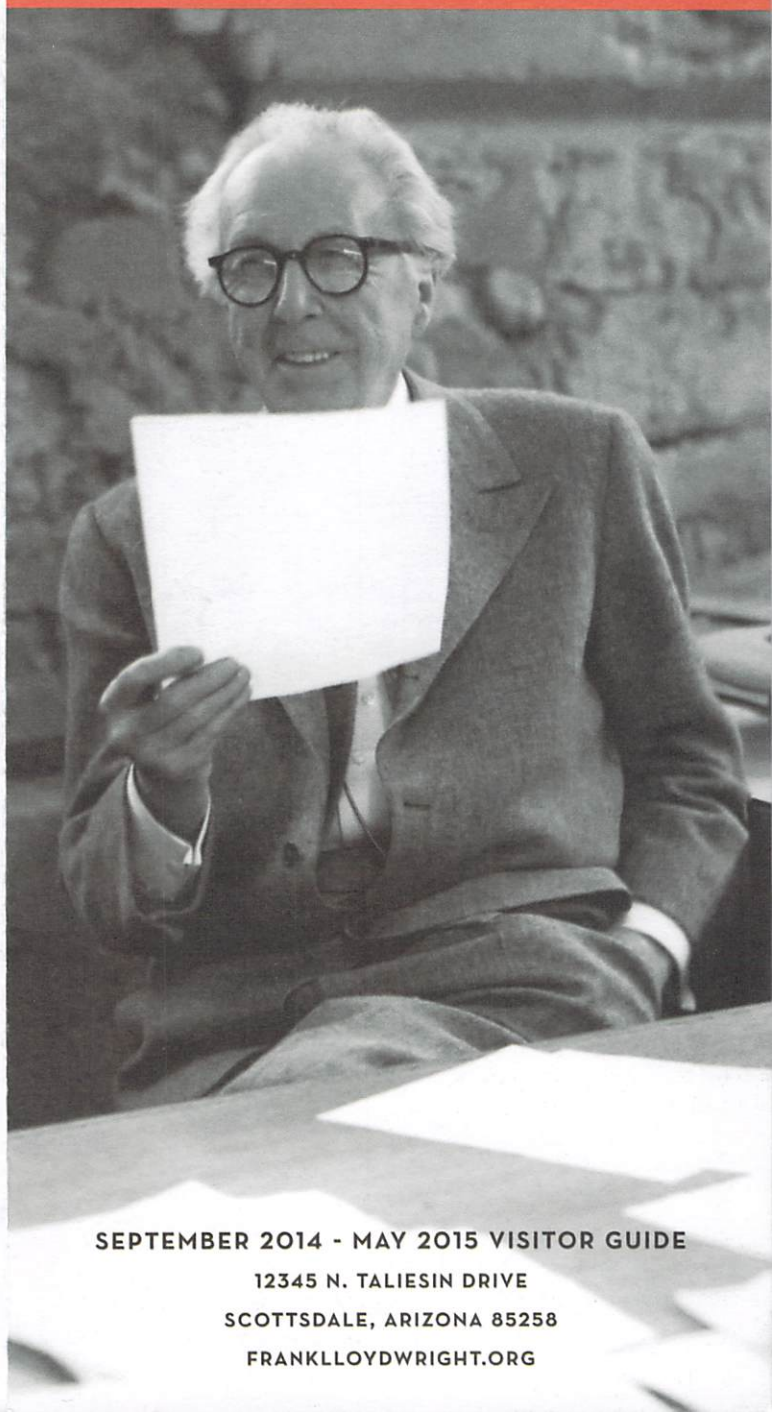
ENTER AT INTERSECTION OF CACTUS RD. AND FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT BLVD.

TALIESIN WEST

Frank Lloyd Wright thought of Taliesin West as a home, workplace, and architectural laboratory. We invite you to visit us today to experience the splendor Frank Lloyd Wright created in the Arizona desert.

Taliesin West is a National Historic Landmark offering a totally immersive tour experience. You will be welcomed into every room and space—nothing on the tour is behind ropes or under glass. Your visit will be filled with surprise, majestic views, and intimate interior details as you discover the places where Frank Lloyd Wright lived, worked and played.

Wright and his apprentices built Taliesin West out of the stone and sand that surrounded them in the Sonoran Desert at the foothills of the McDowell Mountains. Many of those apprentices (“the Fellowship”) who worked and lived alongside Mr. Wright still live at Taliesin West, as do the current students and faculty of the Frank Lloyd Wright School of Architecture—making Taliesin West an ongoing, vibrant community. Visit Taliesin West today and be transformed.

PANORAMA TOUR

1 hour | Offered Daily | Leaves 10:15am & 2:15pm | \$24 advance purchase*, \$28 at Taliesin West

Frank Lloyd Wright's talent for creatively linking indoor and outdoor spaces is on display in this engaging one-hour tour. Visits to the Cabaret Theater, Music Pavilion, and Wright's private office highlight the dramatic beauty of Taliesin West's terraces, gardens, and walkways.

BEHIND THE SCENES TOUR

3 hours | Offered Mondays, Thursdays, & Saturdays, plus November 26 and December 24 | Leaves 9:15am | \$70 advance purchase, \$75 when purchased on site

This is "the tour" for serious architectural enthusiasts. A highlight of this tour is a stop in the colorful Taliesin Fellowship Dining Room where you'll be treated to mid-morning tea. Visit all the spots on the Insights Tour plus another unique desert site. (This tour is not intended for children under the age of 13.) **Reservations required.**

NIGHT LIGHTS TOUR

2 hours | September and May: Friday, 6:30, 7 and 7:30 pm | October, February, March, & April: Friday, 6, 6:30 and 7 pm | December 26, 27, 29 & 30: 5:30, 6, and 6:30pm | \$35 advance purchase, \$40 when purchased on site

The romance of Taliesin West comes to life during this special evening tour. Taliesin West's fire-breathing dragon makes a guest appearance while Wright's desert masterpiece glows warmly like a jewel spotlighted by the bright Arizona moon. (This tour is not intended for children under the age of 13.) **Reservations required.**

DESERT TOURS

Desert tours require appropriate footwear. No children under 12 on these tours. Reservations requested, but not required.

DESERT WALK

90 minutes | Offered Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays & Sundays from November-April (Weather permitting) | Leaves 11am | \$32 advance purchase, \$36 when purchased on site

Explore the rugged desert trails and stunning vistas surrounding Taliesin West. On this guided nature walk you will see first hand the desert vegetation and land forms that were translated into design elements by Frank Lloyd Wright.

DESERT/INSIGHTS TOUR

2 hours | Offered Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays & Sundays from November-April (Weather permitting) | Leaves 9am | \$52 advance purchase, \$56 when purchased on site

This combination tour offers all the experiences of our Insights Tour and Desert Walk rolled into one complete package.

DESERT "SHELTER" TOUR

2 hours | Offered Saturdays from mid-November-April (Weather permitting) | Leaves 1:15pm | \$40 advance purchase, \$45 when purchased on site

Students in the Frank Lloyd Wright School of Architecture lead dynamic desert tours of the their student shelter housing which have been called, "the coolest dorms in the world." Tour guests will learn about the innovative shelter program at Taliesin West, a tradition that has existed since Frank Lloyd Wright first slept under the stars in a simple canvas shelter on the grounds that would become Taliesin West.
