OOPS - I goofed. I responded with words that could be used for the HTML <meta> tag, called "keywords". As Ali reminds us:

"XML doesn't do anything and was created to structure,store and transport information.On the other hand HTML is about displaying information.XML is a complement to HTML."

Also, Lecture 5 suggests metadata for RSS (which is written in XML) as:

Means of creation of the data

Purpose of the data

Time and date of creation

Creator or author of data

Location on a computer network where the data was created
